"To be nominated by my peers is a tremendous gift," McDonald told the crowd of about 300 scholarship recipients, family members and donors.

He spoke of statistics showing Tuscola is in the top 8 percent statewide out of 460 high schools, and fifth in the region. Last year's graduates received \$6.3 million in scholarship offers. "You hear negative things about education, but show me what we're doing poorly. I don't see it," he said. "We have more students in AP (advanced placement) classes than ever before. Tonight shows what we're doing right."

Parris has been the band director at Bethel Middle School for 13 yars, and the number of students participating in the program has grown from 7 percent to 35 percent. The school's student yearbook was dedicated to him this year.

"You guys are the superstars tonight," Parris told the crowd. "I appreciate all you and your parents do, and I appreciate ,y time at Bethel. I do love my kids."

This year's special recognition for Volunteer of the Year went to Canton attorney Pat Smathers.

Tom Posey, one of the longest serving foundation board members, praised Smathers for bringing in more than \$1 million in bequeaths and assets through his work with clients looking for a way to provide a lasting legacy in the community.
